CELEBRATING A DECADE LONG JOURNEY OF

Academic Excellence

The Founders of VGU initiated their commitment to education with the establishment of Gramothan Vidyapeeth in Nagaur in 1992. The pioneering 'Shiksha Karmi' initiative was focused on educating rural women, particularly the daughter-in-laws. Expanding its academic footprint, in the year 2000, they founded the Swami Keshvanand Institute of Technology, Management & Gramothan (SKIT) in Jaipur. This was followed by the establishment of the Marudhar Engineering College (MEC) in Bikaner in 2003, marking a significant milestone as the region's first self-financed engineering college.

The year 2008 witnessed a transformative phase with the creation of the Vivekananda College of Engineering (VCE), and Vivekananda Institute of Technology (VIT) affiliated to Rajasthan Technical University and approved by the AICTE, later VCE was renamed as VIT East.

One of the major transition of this visionary journey occurred in 2012 with the establishment of Vivekananda Global University (VGU) under Act No. 11 of 2012 passed by Rajasthan State Legislative. Commencing its first academic session in 2013, VGU initially housed four faculties – Engineering and Technology, Management, Basic and Applied Sciences, and International Trade and Commerce. Over the years, VGU has flourished into an academic powerhouse with 23 dynamic departments, offering 51+ programmes and led by 14+ faculties.

VGU is a provisional member of AIU (Association of Indian Universities), globally recognized and approved by various regulatory bodies/National and International academic organizations, like the Bar Council of India (BCI), the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), the Council of Architecture (CoA), the Institute of Town Planners India (ITPI, New Delhi), and Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). The academic journey of VGU reached significant milestones when VGU was awarded Grade A+ accreditation by NAAC in 2022 and secured UGC 12B status in 2023. These recognitions exemplify VGU's commitment to academic excellence and continuous improvement.

Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), part of Vivekananda Global University, entered virtual education in October 2022, enrolling 200 learners in the first batch for UGC-entitled online degrees in Online MBA, BCA, and BBA. Using a robust Learning Management System, CDOE integrates virtual sessions, forums, videos, and assessments for a dynamic learning experience. The inaugural batch excelled in July 2023 end-term exams with 85% success. Expanding in July 2023, CDOE added MCA, MSc-Mathematics, MA-English, and BA programs, boasting seven UGC-entitled Online Degree Programs. Enrollment tripled to over 600, reflecting trust in CDOE's commitment. Industry-oriented sessions, led by experts, explored AI, procurement, Generative AI, and ITSM consulting. The Learner Support Team ensured constant connection, contributing to CDOE's success in delivering quality online education.

Further solidifying its academic standing, VGU actively engaged in over 120+ government collaborations, facilitating initiatives that bridge academia and governance. Boasting 25+ Student Welfare Clubs, the university showcased its commitment to a holistic educational experience. VGU's club life is a vibrant tapestry encompassing cultural, technological, entrepreneurial, and environmental pursuits. These clubs serve as platforms for students to explore their passions, contribute to the community, and develop into well-rounded individuals ready to face the challenges of the world beyond academia. The events organized by these clubs witness the participation of 1000+ students from 300+ universities and schools, highlighting the inclusive and engaging nature of VGU's extracurricular activities.

As VGU prepares for its 7th Convocation Ceremony, memories of the previous six echo with the presence of distinguished dignitaries, marking significant milestones in the university's academic journey. Diversity is a cornerstone of the VGU experience, as students from 32 States & UTs and 29 countries converge to pursue over 51 programmes, totaling an enrollment of 10,000+ students. The university takes pride in its innovative program offerings, including Dual Degrees, Minor Degrees, and courses aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP). Embracing the NEP, VGU's education model incorporates Dual, Joint, and Twin Degrees, allowing for Credit Transfers from both National and International Universities within a flexible Choice-based Credit Framework.

The spnsoring body Bagaria Education Trust (BET), has always advocated the concept of entrepreneurship and encouraged the students to be the job providers. The student Startups have been provided space on the campus and seed money by BET. In a pioneering move for this, VGU has launched India's first functional Atal Community Innovation Centre (ACIC-VGU Foundation), underlining its commitment to fostering innovation and community engagement. These features and the establishment of the Swavalamban Chair by SIDBI collectively contribute to VGU's standing as a forward-thinking institution, dedicated to providing a transformative and globally relevant education which further demonstrate VGU's commitment to fostering entrepreneurship, innovation, and a vibrant academic community. So far, VGU has supported 152 startups and ACIC-VGU has disbursed Rs 1.16 Cr. to 13 startups from the Rs 2.00 Cr. received in seed funding, supporting entrepreneurship through grants and debt under the Startup India Seed Fund Scheme. The success stories of incubated startups, such as Kavadea, Kalpurze, Quantum Robotics, AgriCo, ShelterGo, and HiCircle, highlight the impactful contributions to the innovation ecosystem.

As Vivekananda Global University celebrates a decade of transformative education, it stands at the threshold of a future filled with promise and potential. The next decade holds exciting prospects for growth, exploration, and continued academic excellence as VGU continues to shape the leaders, thinkers, and change-makers of tomorrow.

Further, the university/college needs to abide by the following requirements during the entire period of accreditation.

1. Self-Study Reports of all accredited programmes should be uploaded on university website with intimation of necessary link immediately.

 University/college should annually upload intake data of students in all accredited degree programme(s), college-wise faculty positions on its website for information of stakeholders.

 Student intake capacity of the accredited UG/PG/PhD degree programme(s) must be maintained during the accreditation period. Any increase in the student intake capacity during accreditation period without permission of the NAEAB will be liable to cancel the accreditation.

 Strength of faculty/technical /supporting staff as listed in latest year of Self-Study Reports must be maintained by the university/college/programme.

5. A mid-term review will be conducted on actionable points (Annexure-II). The university is required to address the observations on actionable points in a time bound manner and submit Action Taken Report (ATR) accordingly.

Administrative Branch

Simultaneously, the installation of CCTV cameras across the campus ensured a secure and monitored atmosphere for both students and staff.

We established a cutting-edge Audio-Visual (AV) Room, equipped with the latest technology to enhance the learning and presentation experiences. The AV Room setup includes high-quality camera, teleprompter, multimedia projectors, interactive displays, and video-conferencing capabilities, creating a versatile space for lectures, presentations, online teaching and collaborative activities. The procurement of ergonomic and aesthetically pleasing furniture has enhanced the overall living and dining experience for our students.

Our commitment to sustainability is reflected in the implementation of a strategy to repair and refurbish items, thereby extending their lifespan. In line with the broader digital transformation trend, we have successfully digitized our procurement processes. To promote the essential hygiene of our female students, we provisioned Pad Vending Machines.

With the annual migration of a significant number of students from various States, including international students, the scenario in our University inevitably poses distinctive security challenges. In response to these ever-evolving security threats, VGU's security apparatus has undergone a significant overhaul and has been appropriately upgraded. Throughout this academic session, our Security Teams have demonstrated exceptional performance, ranging from securing buildings and managing traffic to diffusing anti-social behaviour among students. To address specific challenges, we have increased the number of guards, ensuring the safety of both staff and students, as also safeguarding the interests of the University. Our Security Teams underwent a revamp, which included rigorous training, regular briefings, and provisioning of new uniforms to establish a sense of authority, professionalism, and safety.



Through the refinement of the traffic plan, and by establishing the student's vehicle parking outside the campus, we transformed the campus into a Vehicle-Free Zone, fostering a safer environment for students. Our Security Teams have anticipated various risks, problems, and challenges, approaching them with a strategy characterized by an 'Iron Hand with a Velvet Glove' attitude. We have constituted a team to counter force majeure and unforeseen incidents. Our training programs and professional briefings for security guards, conducted by trained professionals from the Army, Air Force, and Fire Officers, provide our Security Teams with an additional edge to perform and function with expertise. As regards, the Hostels and Students' Mess is concerned, we undertook some exhaustive efforts for the overall betterment of these entities to include augmenting the supervisory staff.

Our Maintenance and Infrastructure Section too has taken a quantum leap. We have streamlined the procedure of complaint registration, its escalation, and quick resolution by facilities management staff. To improve the productivity levels of our teams, we have refined the demand and procurement process to reduce the downtime of various facilities.

In the past six-months, our in-house maintenance teams have undertaken a plethora of construction, repair and maintenance activities to include all the teaching spaces, as also the Boys and Girls Hostels. We established a new drinking water setup having a capacity of 3000 ltrs for Boys Hostel Singar-1 & Singar-2. In the Students' Mess, we upgraded the food serving area at lower ground and ground floor and established a new drinking water setup. We renovated some classrooms and converted them into new Lecture Theatres. Continuing with our efforts to improve the housekeeping of our University, we have hired the services of a Gurgaon-based Integrated Facility Management Company 'Tenon'. Tenon commenced its operation on 01 Oct 2023, and their machine-based cleaning operations has improved the housekeeping of the University campus manifold.

CDOE, VGU, now proudly boasts a portfolio of seven UGC-entitled Online Degree Programs, including Online MBA, BBA, MCA, BCA, MSC-Mathematics, MA-English, and BA.The July 2023 batch saw a remarkable rise in enrollment, with over 600 learners embracing the opportunities presented by the five operational online degree programs- Online MBA, BBA, MCA, BCA, MSC-Mathematics. In addition, 7 partnerships/collaborations and 10 ideas have been incubated by us.

In collaboration with CrewareCoworks, we organized an exclusive evening "Founders Unwind" on 28 August 2023, wherein 25+ Startup Founders across Rajasthan conglomerated to have an insightful discussion on the latest trends in the start-up industry.

Code Red 3.0 Triathlon, a groundbreaking event, organized by us from 26 October to 29 October 2023at the Vivekananda Global University, intertwined coding, design, and innovation to address global challenges. Open to students and professionals nationwide, it aimed to bridge the gap between ideas and practical applications, nurturing grassroot innovators in fields like craft, design, handicrafts, fashion, and agriculture.

The event comprised of a 72-hour Hackathon for real-world problem solving, a 48-hour Design-athon using waste materials and virtual products, and a 24-hour Youth Ideathon for student entrepreneurship. Cash prizes totaling Rs 7.50 lakhs were up for grabs, making it an inspiring opportunity to learn, innovate, and create solutions for real-world issues. The workshop series on Design Thinking, Critical Thinking, and Innovation Design, conducted from 13 - 17 Feb2023, was another significant initiative. Led by industry experts, the series equipped students with the skills required for effective problemsolving and innovative thinking. Practical applications of these concepts were explored, bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and hands-on experience.

These initiatives underscore the commitment of our council to promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship. By aligning with the directives of the IIC and the Ministry of Education, the council continues to be a driving force behind VGU's mission to produce creative thinkers, problem solvers, and future industry leaders. As we look forward to more exciting endeavors, the councilremains a cornerstone in the university's journey towards fostering innovation and igniting the entrepreneurial spirit among its students.



R & D CELL - VGU

Research and Development Cell

In the dynamic landscape of academia, Vivekanand Global University is making remarkable strides in research and development, showcasing an unwavering dedication to innovation. Through the Seed Money Scheme, we've greenlit 23 proposals with a combined cost of Rs 11.70 lakhs. Of this, Rs 8.24 lakhshas been disbursed, and an impressive Rs 3.11lakhs has been effectively utilized, catalyzing a diverse range of research initiatives.

This session, our researchers have left an indelible mark with 199 research paper publications, including 45 in SCI/WOS/NAAS, 79 in Scopus, and 75 in UGC Care, contributing significantly to the academic discourse. Our commitment to pushing the boundaries is further exemplified by 8 patent publications, comprising 2 granted patents and 2 copyrighted works.

Securing funding is pivotal, and University has achieved this triumphantly with 5 sanctioned research projects from the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, and grants from IUAC, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, DST, and SERB, amassing a total of Rs 2.02 crores. In the academic session 2023-2024, we've welcomed 19 JRF/SRF and 63 PhD candidates, with 13 scholars successfully defending their PhD viva voce examinations.

The R&D cell, as a beacon of progress, is steering the ship in managing the Transdisciplinary Project under NEP 2020 for UG first-year students from the session 2023-2024. These accomplishments encapsulate University's commitment to shaping a future where our contributions to research and development transcend boundaries.
