About the conference:

NCPHP -2019 is being organized with a view to address the problems associated with post harvest processing of major crops and commodities of Rajasthan and value addition of their processed products in order to improve the level of food processing in the state.

Post harvest processing (PHP) is inter-disciplinary area applied to agricultural produce after harvest for its protection, conservation, processing, packaging, distribution, marketing and utilization to meet the food and nutritional requirements of the people in relation to their needs. The importance of PHP lies in the fact that it provides opportunity to meet food security of the growing population by eliminating avoidable losses making more nutritive food items from low grade raw commodity by proper processing, grading and fortification and by-products into nutritive animal feed. The purpose of PHP is to maintain or increase product quality and make it readily marketable.

PHP as a part of horticultural allied sector has special significance in Rajasthan related to main source of income during drought years and provision of supplementary income in normal years. Crops like Guar, Pearl millet, Mustard, Aloe vera, Seed spices, Fenugreek, Gram, Henna etc. have potential in export for which post harvest practices may help to build a viable research industry. Farmers have been losing the value of their fruits and vegetables before they reach to the end consumer in the range of 30-40 percent due to mechanical handling during harvesting, packaging, transportation, wholesale and retail markets and many others after harvesting handling processes. The post harvest losses can be reduced by quality packaging, temperature management, general education related to the needs for maintaining quality and safety of perishables at different levels viz., producer, wholesaler and retailer.

Market value, food safety, lower income may arise due to lack of maintenance of physical attributes and quality of the perishables. Researchers have found potentials in post-harvest technologies for financial returns. There is a lack of information regarding training activities, educational programs on post harvest technology, costs and financial benefits, documentation of losses etc. This sector needs priority attention to overcome the above stated challenges and bring more opportunities in post harvest research and outreach.

Thrust areas:

1. Post-harvest management adopted in major horticultural crops.
An overview of value addition in fruits, vegetables, flower crops, plantation and medicinal crops products in India
2. Post harvest practices adopted for financial benefits of farmers.
3. Food safety during processing and packaging technologies, quality maintenance and inadequacies in policies and infrastructure.
4. Assessment of post harvest losses, industrial application of byproducts processed after harvesting and poor marketing system.
5. Studies of recyclable packages, low-cost energy sources for post harvest uses and safer ripening system and cooling system.
6. Treatments adopted to standardize the food quality assurance and practice of different cultural methods in post-harvest technology.

Call for papers:

Papers are invited on the thrust areas as indicated. The paper presenters may refer to the suggested guidelines.

Guidelines for paper presenters:

Delegates may present their theoretical, conceptual, and empirical papers in the Conference. Empirical research abstract/full length papers submitted for presentation must be original, previously unpublished and not under consideration for publication. The full length paper should not exceed 6000 words. Manuscript of full papers should contain title, affiliation, abstract, introduction, materials and discussion. The abstract of the empirical paper should be written within 250-300 words mentioning keywords, objectives, hypothesis, methods, results and conclusion. The abstract/full paper should be typed in MS Word Times New Roman, 12 fonts with 1.5 line spacing. All data must invariably be given in metric and decimal system. Data presented in figures should not be duplicated in tables and vice versa. All figures and tables should be cited in text and should have concise and self-explanatory headings. The results should be based on statistical analysis with minimum data. Besides invited papers covering key issues, there will be oral and poster presentations. The full length selected papers will be published in proceedings and National Journal "Khoj", P-ISSN: 2349-8749. Delegates are requested to kindly send the soft copies of their Abstracts and full length paper/articles for publication to Organizing Secretary on email: pht2019@vgu.ac.in. TA& DA will be borne by the participants, themselves only.
